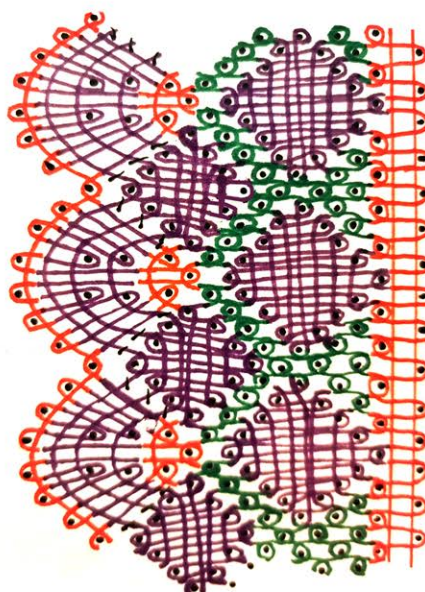
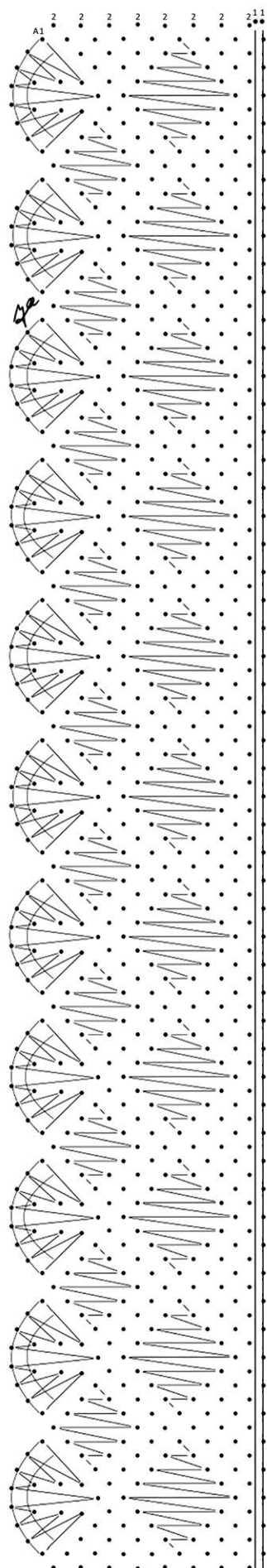


19 pairs of bobbins

This pattern, designed by Jackie Magnin, is a replica of an original specimen of Headford Lace dated ca. 1904 that came from Headford Castle.
